- Your name
- A title

- The definition of an equation.
- The definition of an inequality.
- You may include clipart, wordart, appropriate inserts and examples, sounds (power points), motion.

Make your project colorful and creative but most importantly organized correctly. The goal of this activity is to organize the information in a logical manner. Have fun with adding mathematically appropriate pictures from clip-art, etc.

When you finish, you will NOT print this today. However, you need to save it as follows:
